At the Time of Death

Your funeral director will need the official military discharge service record, specifically VA Form DD214 to obtain benefits for honorably discharged veterans. We will:

- Assist in securing all applicable benefits (including VA Burial Marker, Burial Flag, Burial Benefits, and Presidential Memorial Certificate).
- Arrange Military Honors, including "Taps" and American Flag
 presentation at ceremony or burial location
